Total Grant: £12,080

Identified Issues/Gaps in Learning

- Significant drop in maths, reading and writing attainment across the school
- Y6 children's attainment lower than expected
- Writing and phonics progress stalled across the school
- Social and emotional need for pupils across the school
- Not all children are able to access online learning from home should the school/bubble be forced to close.
